Suggested Equipment List

- Waterproof Hiking Boots (good grip sole & heal)
- Waterproof Rain Gear (top & bottom) (tough with a minimum of sweating characteristics)
- Good/Warm Sleeping Bag
- Duffle Bags (2 bags 35 pounds each - *No giant duffel bags, hard gun cases, or suitcases on bush plane*)
- Soft Gun Case
- Warm Coat
- Cotton Pants
- Wool/Fleece Pants
- Long-Underwear (top & bottoms)
- Underwear, T-shirts & Handkerchiefs
- Wool/Fleece/Flannel Shirt
- Wool/Fleece Sweater/Jacket
- Tennis Shoes/Slippers (to wear when drying out your Hiking Boots)
- Unlined Gloves
- Lined Warm Gloves (2 Pair - Gore-Tex/Insulated are best)
- Warm Hat with Flaps/Stocking Cap
- Ball Cap
- Wool & Cotton Socks
- Pocket/Hunting/Skinning Knife
- Waterproof Matches & "Bic" Lighter
- Plastic Water Bottle (quart size)
- Small Day Backpack (to carry lunch/ammo/water/raingear)
- Lightweight Flashlight & Batteries
- Candle
- Wrist or Pocket Watch
- Soap/Shampoo/Shaving Kit
- Rifle & Ammunition
- Binoculars
- Camera/Film/Batteries
- Lip Balm, Sunscreen, Aspirin, Roloids, Band-Aids, Moleskin, Moist Toweletts, etc.
- Prescription Medicine
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Passport / Custom Papers
- Lens paper
- Towel/Wash Cloth
- Felt insoles

Optional: Spotting Scope with Scope Caps, Pen, Pencil, Paper, Moisturizer, Snow Seal (Waterproof), Gaiters, Candy, Liquor or Beer (Limit 1), Sunglasses, Gore-Tex Sleeping Bag Cover

Sheep Hunts (Hunts #1, #2, #3 & #4): Framed or Internal Frame Backpack on most sheep hunts; Waterproof Hiking Boots (Make sure they are broken in!). Fleece clothing is warm, lightweight and dries quickly -Think light!

Mixed Bag Hunts (Hunts #4, #5, #6 & #7): Insulated Hiking Boots or Waterproof Boots with Thinsulate removable Liners ("Snow Packs") (extra pair of liners), Wool Clothing,

Fishing: You may or may not have time for fishing. It depends on where you will be hunting. Lightweight collapsible fishing gear is recommended. Spinners, spoons and small flies work well. Please let us know if you want a fishing license.

No Giant Duffle Bags Will Be Flown Into Camp
Pack two duffle bags at 35 pounds each - Keep gear to 75 pounds plus rifle
Buy quality gear! Be familiar with your equipment!
Use common sense on weight and amount of gear you bring
There will be a scale at the Whitehorse hotel for your use.
(Your hard gun case, extra gear, suit cases, etc. must be left at the hotel in Whitehorse)
